Not a single Conservative Councillor voted for this fair solution. The Tories promised to delay the closure while volunteers are organised.

Has this 'delay' in closing Kirby Library anything to do with the local elections? Liberals will continue to campaign to keep all libraries open.

Community Politics

Other politicians, once elected, tend to ignore the people they represent. Liberals campaign

with people to achieve benefits for all. This is 'community politics'. The IBERAL result is a stronger community working together to achieve a collective aim.

The Old Library

Liberals in Kirkbymoorside believe creating a 'Town Hall' for a small town is wrong. The cost is £160 for every household. Liberals believe it should benefit Kirby people.
